

- **We raise funds for our members**: Interreg, Horizon 2020, EU Monitoring Observatory for cycling, etc.


















Railway Passenger Rights Regulation

German railways, ICE 4








Czech railways, EC train







Figure 3: Cycle carriage on international train connections



Lines represent train links between cities with one change or less to make the connection. Information in the image is regarding fully assembled bicycles.









"Railway undertakings shall enable passengers to bring bicycles on to the train, where appropriate for a fee, if they are easy to handle, if this does not adversely affect the specific rail service, and if the rollingstock so permits."



Commission proposal



"Passengers shall be **entitled** to take bicycles on board the train, where appropriate for a reasonable fee. They shall keep their bicycles under **supervision** during the journey and ensure that no inconvenience or damage is caused to other passengers, mobility equipment, luggage or rail operations. The carriage of bicycles may be refused or restricted for safety or operational reasons, provided that railway undertakings, ticket vendors, tour operators and, where appropriate, station managers inform passengers of the conditions for such a refusal or restriction in accordance with Regulation (EU) No 454/2011."







"Passengers shall be entitled to take bicycles on board the train, including on high speed, long distance, cross-border and local services. All new or refurbished passenger rolling stock shall, at the latest two years after the entry into force of this regulation, include a well indicated designated space for the carriage of assembled bicycles with a minimum of 8 spaces. Railway undertakings, ticket vendors, tour operators and, where appropriate, station managers shall inform passengers at the latest when purchasing the ticket of the conditions for bicycle carriage on all services in accordance with Regulation (EU) No 454/2011."

Remove refusal/restriction of bicycle carriage for safety or operational reasons

WHAT IS INTELLIGENT SPEED ASSISTANCE?



1. Car receives position information via GPS and current speed limit from a digital map. Can also be combined with video camera sign recognition.

Driver can override system by pushing harder on accelerator 3. Car helps driver not to speed when speed limit is reached.

Speed limit is displayed

on the dashboard.

 ECF Recommendation – EP and Council to hail this as flagship EU road safety measure



Trucks/HGVs



- Around 25% of cycling fatalities as a result of crashes with large vehicles
- Autonomous Emergency Braking/turning assist for HGVs
- Direct Vision finally a standard for trucks!

ECF Recommendation – include emergency braking with detection systems/Vision standard shorter lead in time





Road Infrastructure Safety Management Directive



Problem: TEN-T infrastructure projects include unsafe cycling infrastructure



EC proposal for amending the RISM directive



- Significant extension of scope from TEN-T network only to all motorways, primary roads and EU-funded rural roads
- Needs of cyclists have to be taken into account in the implementation of directive procedures

ECF: publish guidelines on HOW to take into account the needs of cyclists

- minimum quality requirements
- necessary for countries lacking knowledge where and how to design safe cycling infrastructure
- include cycling infrastructure in training/certification of road safety auditors









Motor Insurance Directive



Electric Powered Assisted Cycle





- < 25 kmh assistance cuts out
- < Less 250 Watts Power
- *Pedal* assisted no pedal no power
- Regulated like bicycles at CEN/ISO not type approved
- Treated like bicycles across EU

 All benefits of a bicycle and overcomes many of the barriers








VAT



What is the situation today? VAT for cycling



- Standard VAT rate on bicycle sales
- Member States can introduce reduced VAT rate on bicycle repair.
 - Currently used by: BE,
 IE, LU, MT, NL, PL, PT, SI





What does the Commission propose?



- keep standard VAT rate of at least 15%
- give Member States much more flexibility on reduced rates:
 - Member States choose on which goods + services they apply reduced or 0% rates
- introduce list of goods on which standard VAT rate has to be applied:
 - weapons, gambling, alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, consumer electronics, petrol + diesel passenger vehicles, fuel

Obligatory standard VAT

Combustion engine cars

E-bikes

Reduced VAT possible

E-cars

Classic bikes

 Means: Electric bikes + LEVs disadvantaged compared to electric cars; MS cannot use VAT as an incentive for promoting e-bikes + LEV uptake




Cycling tourism trips in Europe


