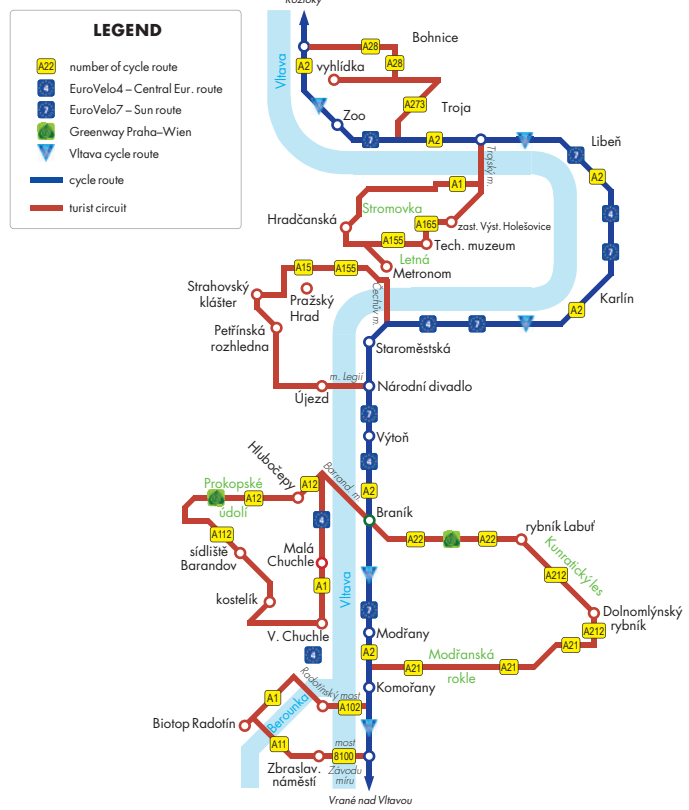

- 5 PRAGUE CASTLE**

Prague castle is the most important monument in the city, a symbol of Czech history and listed as a UNESCO World Heritage site within the historical centre. It was the seat of Czech counts and kings and since 1918 it has become the seat of Czech presidents. The castle system consists of a few courtyards, palace buildings, the president's residence, towers and the St. Vitus Cathedral, dominating the view of Hradčany. [Source: mapy.cz]

- 8 PREMONSTRATE CLOISTER**

Premonstrate cloister, established in 1140, got its baroque look in the 17th century. Its dominant part is the basilica of the Assumption of the Virgin Mary, where W.A. Mozart improvised on an organ during his stay in Prague in 1787. In the cloister, there is the Museum of Czech Literature. [Source: mapy.cz wikipedia.cz]

- 9 THE CHURCH OF SAINT NICHOLAS**

The Church of Saint Nicholas is an important Prague baroque monument in the Lesser Town. Its creation was initiated by Jesuits and it was constructed in two stages throughout the 18th century. Its cupola is of extraordinary size, reaching an impressive 20 metres in diameter and 79 metres in height. Famous baroque artists took part in the interior decoration (Jan Lukáš Kracker, Josef Kramolín and Karel Škréta). [Source: stnicholas.cz]

- 10 LENNON WALL**
Velkopřevorské náměstí
The Lennon Wall is situated in Prague Kampa. The wall is full of colours and is in remembrance of the famous frontman of the legendary rock group, The Beatles This wall is one of Prague's must-see monuments. It has become a place where people honour the well-known music icon, but also a place where people expressed their opinion and protested against the communist regime. [Source: praguecityline.cz]

- 11 PETŘÍN TOWER**

In 1889, 363 members of the Czech Tourist Club went to the World Exhibition in Paris where the Eiffel Tower amazed them, so the idea to build Petřín Tower was born. You can get to the tower, the construction of which took only four months, by cable car. The highest platform of 55 meters can then be reached by stairs or by elevator. [Source: mapy.cz]

- 12 KAMPA**
Kampa Island lies on the left bank of the Vltava River. Its northern part is named Prague Venice. Mills were here before, with the most famous of those being Šovů's mills, where Museum Kampa is now situated, serving as a gallery. Moreover, in Šovů's mills you can find a luxury restaurant with an amazing view of the river. Next to it, there is the Babies statue from sculptor David Černý. EUROVELO CYCLE ROUTES

EuroVelo is a network of long distance cycle routes, connecting European countries and reaching beyond the continent. Routes are marked according to the methodology of the respective state with the EuroVelo sign added, consisting of a number (route sequence number) in a blue field, surrounded by twelve yellow stars. Altogether, 15 routes are marked in Europe. More information about the project can be found here: www.eurovelo.com.



EuroVelo 7 The approximate 7 400 km Sun Route, will take you from the land of the midnight sun to islands located in the Mediterranean. Culture, sunlight, mountain air and a good dose of history make for an unforgettable adventure. The chance of you getting bored is infinitely small: you can visit nine European countries (including stops in the cycling havens of Malmo, Copenhagen, Berlin and Bolzano); traverse the Alps, venture to the tip of the 'Italian boot'; and experience the sunny archipelago of Malta to mention but a few highlights. Well, what are you waiting for?!



OTHER LONG DISTANCE CYCLE ROUTES RUNNING THROUGH PRAGUE



VLTAVA CYCLE ROUTE

Vltava Cycle Routes starts from Vltava river spring on Šumava Mountains. It goes across Prague and it achieves confluence of Elbe and Vltava rivers at Mělník. This cycle routes is parallel to Eurovelo 7 - Sun route.



PAN-EUROPEAN CYCLE ROUTE

Pan-European Cycle Route is 1.537 km long connecting Paris and Prague. It starts in Paris and goes across Strasbourg, Heidelberg to Nuremberg. It comes to Czech Republic as cycle route n. 37 and goes across Plzeň and Beroun (parallel to EuroVelo 4 - Central Europe Route). The end of this cycle route is in Prague.

GREENWAYS

Greenway is one of successful project founded by Nadace Partnerství. Greenways are lines in landscape used for relaxation, sport and non-motorized transport. It naturally exists along rivers. Some canceled railway lines are used for Greenways too.



Greenways Praha-Vienna is long distance cycle route connecting two famous culture cities in central Europe. Let come to explore historical towns and villages, visit romantic castles and medieval monasteries, experience traditional craft in old workshops and taste Moravian wine..



Coordination of the development and promotion of these routes is carried out by the **Environmental Partnership Foundation**. Foundation also provides a **'Cyclists Welcome'** certificate for participants (accommodation and rations) and some tourist targets, helping to provide the basic needs of cyclists. It served as a textile factory and gallery and presently the chateau is not open to the public. You can admire the building of former convent, prelaty and church where the remains of important members of the House of Přemyslovci are laid.

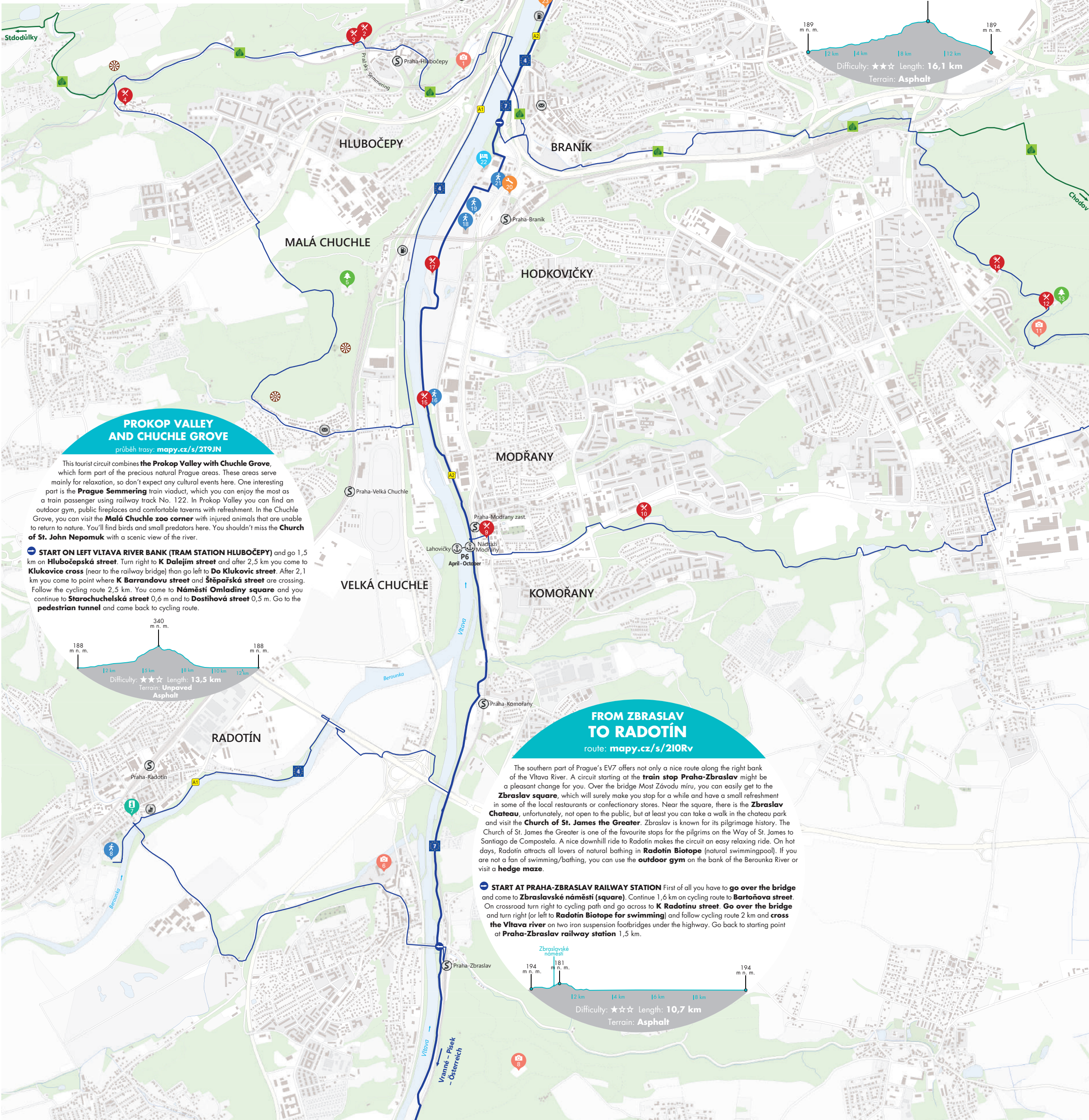

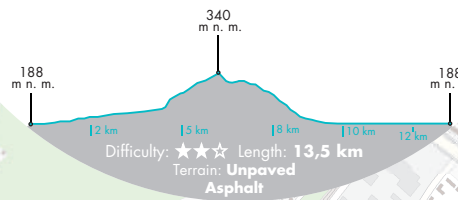


PROKOP VALLEY AND CHUCHLE GROVE

This tourist circuit combines the **Prokop Valley with Chuchle Grove**, which form part of the precious natural Prague areas. These areas serve mainly for relaxation, so don't expect any cultural events here. One interesting part is the **Prague Semmering** train viaduct, which you can enjoy the most as a train passenger using railway track No. 122. In Prokop Valley you can find an outdoor gym, public fireplaces and comfortable taverns with refreshment. In the Chuchle Grove, you can visit the **Malá Chuchle zoo corner** with injured animals that are unable to return to nature. You'll find birds and small predators here. You shouldn't miss the **Church of St. John Nepomuk** with a scenic view of the river.

➡ **START ON LEFT VLTAVA RIVER BANK (TRAM STATION HLUBOČEPY)** and go 1,5 km on **Hlubočepská street**. Turn right to **K Dalejím street** and after 2,5 km you come to **Klukovské cross** (near to the railway bridge) then go left to **De Klukovské street**. After 2,1 km you come to point where **K Barrandovu street** and **Štěpánská street** are crossing. Follow the cycling route 2,5 km. You come to **Náměstí Omladiny square** and you continue to **Starochuchelská street** 0,6 km and to **Dostihová street** 0,5 m. Go to the **pedestrian tunnel** and came back to cycling route.

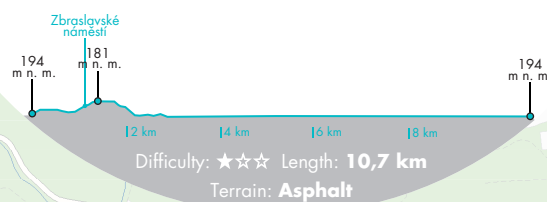


FROM ZBRASLAV TO RADOTÍN

The southern part of Prague's EV7 offers not only a nice route along the right bank of the Vltava River. A circuit starting at the **train stop Praha-Zbraslav** might be a pleasant change for you. Over the bridge Most Závodu míru, you can easily get to the **Zbraslav square**, which will surely make you stop for a while and have a small refreshment in some of the local restaurants or confectionary stores. Near the square, there is the **Zbraslav Chateau**, unfortunately, not open to the public, but at least you can take a walk in the chateau park and visit the **Church of St. James the Greater**. Zbraslav is known for its pilgrimage history. The Church of St. James the Greater is one of the favourite stops for the pilgrims on the Way of St. James to Santiago de Compostela. A nice downhill ride to Radotín makes the circuit an easy relaxing ride. On hot days, Radotín attracts all lovers of natural bathing in **Radotín Biotop** (natural swimmingpool). If you are not a fan of swimming/bathing, you can use the **outdoor gym** on the bank of the Berounka River or visit a **hedge maze**.

➡ **START AT PRAHA-ZBRASLAV RAILWAY STATION** First of all you have to **go over the bridge** and come to **Zbraslavské náměstí (square)**. Continue 1,6 km on cycling route to **Bartoňkova street**. On crossroad turn right to cycling path and go across to **K Radotín street**. **Go over the bridge** and turn right (or left to **Radotín Biotop for swimming**) and follow cycling route 2 km and **cross the Vltava river** on two iron suspension footbridges under the highway. Go back to starting point at **Praha-Zbraslav railway station** 1,5 km.

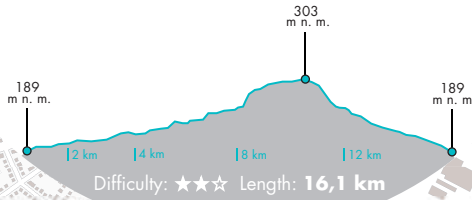


TO KUNRATICE FOREST AND MODŘANY GULLY

Although, it might not seem at the very first sight to be true, **Prague hides fairly large forested areas**. These are not just parks that give Prague a green appearance and a touch of nature. A short distance from the busy streets of the tourist centre, you can easily reach the wilderness of the **Kunratice Forest** on the cycle route EV7. The green cycle route Greenway Prague-Vienna will lead you nicely through Braník and Krč to this forest. Although you will return to a built-up area from the Kunratice Forest, you will soon reach another natural site - **Modřany Gully**, where there is a nature trail with a natural history theme. The trail is especially suitable for parents with children, most stops are complemented by identification quizzes of plants, animals or rocks

➡ **VLTAVA RIVER** On the crossroad turn left and go to **pedestrian tunnel under the Barrandovský bridge**. After 4 km you come to **Labuť lake**. Continue 3,5 km along the Kunratický river to **Dolnomlýnský lake**. Then go 0,6 km to **Ohrada lake**. Turn right to cycling route A21 and you come to **Modřany Gully** after 2,6 km. Follow the cycling signs and you come **back to Vltava river**.
