BASIC CRITERIA FOR A SAFE STATIONLESS BIKE SHARING SYSTEM IN PRAGUE

BICYCLES:

- 1. Must fulfil the conditions required by the Czech legislation, in particular Act no. 56/2001 Sb., on the conditions for operating vehicles on roads and amending Act no. 168/1999 Sb., on liability insurance for damage caused by operating a vehicle and amending certain related acts (the Vehicle Liability Insurance Act), in the wording of Act no. 307/1999 Sb. and by implementing Decree no. 341/2014 Sb., on the approval of technical qualification and technical conditions for operation of vehicles on roads.
- 2. Electric bicycles must conform to ČSN EN 15194+A1 (EPAC).
- 3. They shall be visibly labelled with the name of the operator.
- 4. They shall have a visible unique identification number and the operator shall be able to present the city with a list of bicycles mobile within Prague.
- 5. The telephone number of the system operator shall be placed on them in a visible spot for reporting problems; the telephone number must be on the network of a Czech operator and service must be available to callers 24/7 in both Czech and English.

THE SYSTEM OPERATOR:

- 6. Shall ensure operation of the user application in both Czech and English.
- 7. Shall notify the City of Prague of the identification data of the operator, which shall be a registered entity in the Czech Republic, as well as the designated person with whom it is possible to address all situations concerning the system in Czech.
- 8. Shall inform users intelligibly and visibly about proper and safe bike riding in the city.
- 9. Shall discuss with the affected municipal districts appropriate and safe places to park bikes where they will not restrict or endanger other road users.
- 10. Shall actively inform users of such places and motivate them to use them.
- 11. Shall move inappropriately and unsafely placed bicycles to spots agreed on with the municipal district or to other property where the operator has the owner's consent.
- 12. Shall bear liability for injuries and damages caused by the use and operation of the system, including inappropriately and unsafely parked bikes.
- 13. Shall remove unrideable and damaged bicycles from the public space without delay.
